SVC Products Pty Ltd & Anston Architectural recognises our safety duties under the *Heavy Vehicle National Law (HVNL) 2018* and the *Work Health and Safety Act and 2017 Regulations*, which is to ensure the safety and wellbeing of our Employees, our Drivers, our Customers, and all other Interested Parties whom play a role within the supply and transport cycle of our operations.


SVC Products Pty Ltd & Anston Architectural values the benefits of promoting and maintaining a safe transport operation for its employees, contractors, customers, and other road users. Therefore, we are committed to work in line with and support the regulations of the Heavy Vehicle Master Code 2018.

We do this by:

- Undertaking all transport activities in a way that is as safe as reasonably practicable.
- Encouraging and supporting these same control measures during our scheduling and planning processes with Prime Contractors, Drivers, Loaders, Consignors and Consignees.
- We provide support and training to those employed by the business in Chain of Responsibility through Safe Operating Procedures, regular Toolbox talks, Consultation with Drivers and providing a range of resources to those performing tasks within the Transport cycle. Such as Load Restraint guidelines and online training.
- Our business practices do not encourage Drivers to:
 - Exceed speed limits,
 - Exceed regulated driving hours,
 - Not take their required minimum rest breaks,
 - Nor condone or allow Drivers to leave our premises while impaired by fatigue or other form of health that will compromise the safety of themselves, our employees, our customers and those sharing the road.
- We expect that all Heavy Vehicles and their loads comply with relevant mass and dimension requirements, and that those requirements are verified with each Driver before being loaded.
- We will not and do not condone any person(s) with our CoR to influence the conduct of our business to breach the law.
- We will continue to review and improve our Management System that is supported by the businesses Executive members.
- Incidents do and will continue to be investigated, root cause of incident assessed, and identity of how reasonably practicable controls can be planned and implemented.
